The Land Use System: Setting the Stage

November 29th

Participants will learn about the Land Use System, including the authority and power given to local governments and their land use boards. Session will highlight the importance of comprehensive planning, visioning at a community level, and how planning can set the stage for sustainable development and future community engagement on many land use issues. A hypothetical development project will be used to walk people through the land use process. This session goes beyond board member's legal responsibility and ethical considerations, but instead focuses on creating plans that implement a community's vision for itself.
